our company is not subject due to the Dodd-Frank-Act for obligated companies to declare a disclosure statement. In line with this check-up, we can submit the following information:

Out of the list of conflict minerals there is only tin used as a potential conflict mineral in our solenoids. This material is used by our suppliers in minimal quantities for soldering and tinning copper wires and as a coating on the backside of the steel bushings. For sureness we asked our suppliers to fill in and send the RMI-formular. According to the information provided by our suppliers, we can testify in good belief that these vendor parts do not originate in countries named in Dodd-Frank-Act - Sec. 1502.
